## Tips for Students on Using WebAssign

- (1) Use proper browsers: Firefox or Chrome. Do **not** use Internet Explorer or Safari! They have cookie problems. and may display WebAssign questions without answer boxes. Even if WebAssign works in the bad browsers for a while, they can suddenly stop working.
- (2) Get to WebAssign by HuskyCT, **not** by WebAssign's own website, which asks for a nonexistent class key. In particular, **do not use Google** to find WebAssign. Go into HuskyCT.
- (3) The WebAssign link in HuskyCT is on your discussion section page, not your lecture page.
- (4) In WebAssign a CalcPad appears when the answer is not a simple expression.
- (5) In answers don't mix up capital and lower-case (p vs. P, x vs. X) or x and Greek  $\chi$ .
- (6) If an answer is marked wrong, don't submit it again in an equivalent form: if y = 2(x 1) is wrong, so is y = 2x 2.
- (7) Enter an exact number if not told to round *e.g.*, 4/3 instead of 1.333. Rounding to 4 decimal places means 4 digits *after the decimal point*. Type  $\pi$  with the CalcPad rather than as 3.14.
- (8) Watch out for sign errors: if you mean to type  $\frac{-a+b}{c}$  do **not** type  $-\frac{a+b}{c}$ , which is  $\frac{-a-b}{c}$ . (9) The page http://www.webassign.net/manual/student\_guide/c\_s\_syntax\_errors.htm
- (9) The page http://www.webassign.net/manual/student\_guide/c\_s\_syntax\_errors.htm has tips on avoiding syntax problems when entering your answers on WebAssign.
- (10) For an answer entered into a set of pre-written parentheses, do **not** add your own or it will be marked wrong. In the first answer below, a student added extra parentheses.

$$(x, y) = \left( \left( -\frac{5}{\sqrt{3}}, -\frac{3116}{9} \right) \right) \times \left[ -\frac{5}{\sqrt{3}}, -\frac{3116}{9} \right]$$

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(11) Find the number of attempts allowed on a question with the green + in the circle by the problem number. In the 2nd image below the first 4 parts have tries (see 0/5) and the last has 3 tries (see 0/3).

- (12) In problems with 3 or more chances, get help when you have 2 or more chances left, **not 1**.
- (13) When emailing about a WebAssign exercise, attach a screenshot of the whole exercise.
- (14) Save an electronic copy of homework to work on it offline: click "Print Assignment" at top of assignment and change print setting to "save as pdf."
- (15) Extensions on homework are not usually granted; don't begin an hour before the deadline.
